Online applications are invited from Indian Citizen for recruitment to the Post of General Duty Medical Officer (GDMO) [Special Drive for Reserved Categories-SECOND CYCLE] under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal.

The edit window will be available at the official website of WBHRB (www.hrb.wb.gov.in) from 01.12.2025 (10:00 AM) to 03.12.2025 (05:00PM).

Appointments are temporary but likely to be permanent.

This is a special drive for reserved category. No UR candidates [except UR (PWD)] are eligible to apply against this particular advertisement.

(a) Method of Recruitment: - By selection (direct recruitment) through the West Bengal Health Recruitment Board.

(b) Qualifications:

(i) MBBS degree included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part-II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956) and Registration as Medical Practitioners in the Medical Council of India or any State Medical Council provided that the candidates, if selected and appointed, must Register their name in the West Bengal Medical Council within six months of joining the West Bengal Health Service.

E- Age:

Not more than 36 (thirty six) Years on the 1st day of January of the year of Advertisement for ordinary medical graduates and 40 (forty) Years for those possessing postgraduate qualifications, relaxable for 2 (two) years for otherwise well qualified and experienced candidates;

Provided the age relaxation may be given to such Doctors who have served under this State Government, to an extent equivalent to the period of such regular service, subject to a maximum of 5 (five)years;

Provided further that age relaxation may be given to such Doctors who have served under this State Government, on contractual basis, to an extent equivalent to the period of such service, subject to a maximum of 3(three) years;

Provided further that age may also be relaxable by 5(five) years for the candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Ex-Servicemen & relaxable by 3(three) years for the candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes as per Government rules or orders for the time being in force.

Note:

No application shall be considered unless accompanied by the requisite application fee excepting Candidates belonging to SC/ST category of West Bengal and persons with disabilities specified under Disabilities Rule, 1999 (certificates obtained before the Advertisement date) who do not require to pay any fee. Such exemption of fee is, however, not applicable to any OBC candidate.

A. Candidates are requested to upload all years' Mark Sheet(s) including supplementary mark sheet(s), if any along with passed certificate of MBBS Degree included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part-II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956), in the space provided for the same.

B. The following documents must be uploaded as the proof of aforesaid qualification:

- All years Mark sheets including supplementary mark sheets, if any of MBBS Degree included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part-II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956) along with passed certificate.
- Attempt/Chance Certificate: There is no separate field to upload attempt/chance certificate. 3. Registered as Medical Practitioners in the Medical Council of India or any State Medical Council:

1. Candidate must be registered ON OR BEFORE THE LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS as Medical Practitioners in the Medical Council of India or any State Medical Council and should fill up in specified space provided for the same.
2. Candidates are requested to input "100" marks in "Marks obtained" column and "100" marks in "Full marks" column while filling up the field i.e., Registered as Medical Practitioners in the Medical Council of India or any State Medical Council. No marks will be allotted for uploading the aforesaid certificate though uploading the same is MANDATORY for all.
3. Candidates must upload relevant documents generating a single PDF file or jpeg/jpg/png format with high resolution in the space specified for the same.

N.B:

A. The experience certificate must be issued by the Head of the Institution(s)/ Organisation(s)/ Clinical Establishment(s)/ Hospital(s) where the candidate has worked, in proper letterhead along with requisite seal/stamp, bearing Memo No. and Date of issue of such certificates.

i) For Private Experience, candidates have to produce, copy of the CE License of the Institution/Organisation/Clinical Establishment/Hospital, where the candidate has worked, and copy of the First Month's & Last Month's Pay Slip, corresponding to his/her period of experience, along with the experience certificate.

ii) In case of independent practitioner, the experience certificate as Medical Practitioner, must be issued from the CMOH of the District or concerned Licensing Authority.

iii) In case any independent practitioner, fails to submit experience certificate, issued from the CMOH of the District or concerned Licensing Authority, but produces copy of the CE License, his/her period of experience will be calculated from the date of issuance of such CE License.

B. The candidates possessing the relevant experience must select YES option (Radio Button) in the Experience section.

C. Candidates possessing more than 01(one) experience certificate should click "ADD ROW" button to provide the information of multiple experience certificates.

D. Tenure of any experience should be taken up to the last date of submission of application.

E. Candidates are requested to generate a single running PDF file containing all the relevant certificates of the aforementioned experience and then upload the documents in the "Upload Certificate" space provided for the same.

(d) The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board (WBHRB) may require such further proof or particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries regarding eligibility. Original Certificates relating to citizenship (by registration), age, qualifications, caste (SC/ST/OBC), Physical disability shall have to be submitted when the WBHRB asks for them. K- Instruction to the candidate:

- **DEPARTMENTAL CANDIDATES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE POST. However, those already in regular government service, should not apply.**
- Mere empanelment shall not confer any right to be recommended and/ or appointed.
- **The Board may decide to hold Written Examination or Computer Based Test (CBT), at any subsequent stages of the recruitment process, for short listing of candidates for interview, and/or for preparation of Overall Performance List. Accordingly, the marks distribution pattern, mentioned in clause 'H' of this advertisement, may be changed partially or completely, if such Written Examination or Computer Based Test (CBT) is conducted for recruitment to the above mentioned post.**
- Candidates must fulfil the essential qualification at the time of submission of application. No degree or experience certificate issued after the last date of submission of application will be considered.
- In the event, the last date of submission of online application is extended for whatsoever may be the reason, no particulars and certificates and/ or qualification/experience (either essential or desirable) acquired during such extended period, shall be accepted.
